Lessing Named to Scout Post City Judge Robert Lessing, who was recently elected president of the local co-ordinating council, has undertaken another duty. He will serve as chairman of the Boy Scout field committee for the Pacific area, a newly-created Scout position. The Pacific area field committee consists of district leaders for Torrance, San Pedro, Wilmington, Gardena and Redondo-Hermosa and is a part of the Los Angeles Bay Scout Council. Lessing will direct co-ordination of Scout activities in the harbor section. He will work under Gene Weston, district field executive, according to word received here yesterday from the Los Angeles Scout headquarters.

First Militarized Road Designated by Ohio PARKMAN, O. (U.P.)—Ohio's first militarized road, 2.57 miles long, will pass through here. The project is a section of U. S. Route 422 and is designed as the first step in the militarization of the highway between the Mahoning Valley steel center at Youngstown and industrial Cleveland.

The route is one of the six major highways listed by State Highway Director Robert S. Beightler, who is a National Guard colonel, for permanent improvement as military roads. These are necessary not only for troop movements but for the transportation of essential war materials.

Peanut Crop's Value Shows Steady Increase WASHINGTON (U.P.)—Peanuts and soybeans are two of the more than 100 crops produced commercially in the United States which have increased steadily in value in recent years, according to an Agriculture Department survey.

Income from these two crops last year established new records despite a sharp decrease in total farm income. The peanut crop was sold for \$39,351,000 and the soybean crop for \$31,933,000.
