

# Thomas Has Lead Over O'Toole in Assembly Race

Semi-official election returns from the 68th Assembly District for the primary Aug. 27 give Vincent Thomas, 32-year-old San Pedro, the Democratic nomination by the narrow margin of 63 votes over James J. O'Toole of Torrance. Tabulations in all 123 precincts give Thomas a total of 1,855, according to the semi-official count, while O'Toole received 1,792 or 120 ahead of the third candidate, John T. Rawls of San Pedro who polled 1,672.

Richard Pomeroy of Harbor City apparently placed fourth with 1,629 and John G. Boro of San Pedro trailed with 1,605. O'Toole is not conceding Thomas' election until the vote is canvassed and the absentee ballots counted. He is not decided as yet about demanding a recount. The last recount ordered in this area was in 1936 when Former Assemblyman John Rawls trailed the late Assemblyman Fred Reaves by 156 votes for the nomination. Rawls charged election boards had taken illegal short cuts in counting ballots and in the ensuing recount held under supervision of a superior court judge, he lost 66 more votes to Reaves.

## Candidates Begin Filing Expense Accounts

Filing of expenses of candidates seeking office at the August 27 primaries has started. Among candidates filing expense statements thus far are Hal Hughes, Superior Court \$100; Clarence L. Kincaid, Superior Court, \$90; John T. Rawls, assembly, 68th district, \$115; Vincent Thomas, assembly, 68th district, \$300, and Emmet H. Wilson, Superior Court, \$90.
