

Tartars, Beaten by Narbonne, Play at San Pedro's Navy Field Friday

GAUCHOS GET BYE DATE; 3,000 SEE LOMITA GAME

With a 6 to 0 victory over the Torrance Tartars to their credit on the 1940 Marine League record book, the Narbonne Gauchos are taking a rest tomorrow while their victims of the season's opening game, Coach Robert Barr's Torrance high eleven will clash with San Pedro at Navy Field in the port city, starting at 3 o'clock. San Pedro and Gardena fought to a scoreless draw last Friday at Gardena. Banning will be host to Gardena Friday.

Torrance, outclassed by Narbonne in the opening period when the Gauchos' made their one and only score of the game, rallied in the remaining quarters to hold the Lomitans in check. The Tartars put up, the same kind of performance in the two practice games—after a weak first period gaining strength and aggressiveness to hold their opponents even in the three remaining quarters.

Dick Mertz, younger brother of Narbonne's illustrious Ted Mertz of gridiron fame, broke through tackle and ran 18 yards to the sole touchdown of the game played before nearly 3,000 fans at Lomita. Mertz relieved John Walker near the end of the opening quarter.

Penalties Hit Tartars
The Tartars carried the fight deep into Narbonne territory in the final period. After crossing the mid-field stripe, they took to the air and completed two passes and mixed them with a running attack to reach the 11-yard line. A 15-yard penalty, third of its kind assessed against the Torrance invaders during the day, for ineligible pass receiver set them back on their heels.

The Gauchos, directed by Coach Bill Sloan, threatened on several occasions in all periods

but lacked the punch to score. John Walker was the chief ground gainer with Mertz lending big help. For Torrance rolls: Andrews, Roland Justice, end; Bill Parton and Bobby Golden in the backfield stood out.

Narbonne tallied seven first downs to five for Torrance and gained 218 yards to 132 for Torrance. The Tartars were set back 70 yards in penalties while Narbonne lost only 20 by this route. The Lomitans completed only one of seven attempted passes and Torrance made four of their 10 heaves good. Torrance fumbled four times to Narbonne's one.

San Pedro and Gardena Play Scoreless Tie

With San Pedro's John Gilgo and Gardena's Lowell Wagner, All-League fullback, sharing top honors for the day, the scoreless tie game played last Friday was the first upset of the Marine League season. If either team had won by any margin at all the victor would have been bracketed with Narbonne as potential 1940 champions.

Gilgo was all over the field to either make or help with the defense while Wagner was chief ground gainer for the Mohicans. San Pedro's Pirates, who defeated Torrance last year 32 to 0, met the Tartars on Navy Field tomorrow afternoon.

Yardage for the San Pedro-Gardena game was about even. Gardena gained 158 yards from scrimmage, 37 of which were from passes. San Pedro piled up 141 yards with only 13 on passes. The Bucs had 10 first downs to seven for Gardena, making their best showing with four in the final quarter. Poe of Gardena had the edge on kicking, booting eight times for a 39-yard average. One of the kicks was blocked, making actually only seven to get down the field. One of the boots went 65 yards. Dragich and Dudley averaged 31 yards in seven tries.

Gardena lost 36 yards from scrimmage while San Pedro was set back just half that much, making the net gain for the Mohicans 122 yards and for San Pedro 123. San Pedro fumbled seven times and received six loose balls. Gardena had five fumbles and six recoveries.
