

Gardena, S. P. in Grid Carnival at L. A. Friday

For the purpose of raising money for the Parent-Teachers Association welfare work for underprivileged children, the greatest high school football contest of the season will be staged at the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum, tomorrow (Friday), beginning at 1:45 p. m. This is the High School Football and Band Carnival which is held annually by the Tenth District Congress of Parents and Teachers.

In addition to an exciting football contest in which 12 outstanding high school football teams will participate, 80 high school bands, including Torrance, under the direction of Louis Woodson Curtis, and the colors and color guards of 11 high school R. O. T. C. units will parade in mass formation preceding the football game.

The 12 top-notch football teams of the Los Angeles City School District will clash in an exciting tussle. The teams will be divided into two divisions representing the northern and southern sections of the district. The teams will be paired off against each other and each pair will play for a 20-minute period.

At the end of each playing period the ball will be declared "dead" where it is and the next two teams will take up the game from that point. Constituting a continuous game of six 20-minute periods, this north-south contest promises to be the greatest football spectacle of the year.

Admission to the High School Football and Band Carnival will be 40 cents for adults and 15 cents for students.

Compton Jaysee Has 60 Taking Air Training

Airplane pilot training at Compton Junior College is part of a program encompassing 214 junior colleges last winter, last summer and this fall, and providing air training for more than 9,000 students.

Compton Junior College is listed in the current issue of the Junior College Journal as having offered the pilot training program last winter and last summer and also as having a quota of 50 students for the primary training course and 10 for the advanced course this fall.

Approximately 5,000 civilian pilots in 148 junior colleges successfully completed their primary training course last year, says this article. Quotas of 4,250 students are assigned to 210 junior colleges for the first semester of this year. Most of these are in the primary training course, but 490 have been assigned to the secondary or advanced course.

The primary course includes 72 hours of ground school instruction and from 35 to 45 hours in the air, sufficient to qualify students for private pilots' licenses. The secondary or advanced course deals with CAA regulations, aircraft, engines, meteorology, aerial navigation, instruments and parachutes.

RED CROSS CERTIFIES FOR FOOD STAMPS

Only veterans or their widows of Civil, Spanish American or World War, who are drawing regular pensions or compensation and the total income does not exceed the maximum budget used by the State Relief Administration are eligible for Federal food stamps now being certified thru the American Red Cross. This point was emphasized yesterday by Gurney Newlin, chairman of the Los Angeles Chapter, American Red Cross, following a flood of requests for certification by veterans for these food stamps.

"It is not the aim of the government to make food stamps available to any and all veterans," Newlin pointed out. "The plan is merely a relief measure extended into the ranks of the veterans or their widows who are receiving regular pensions or compensation from the government and who are in need of this supplementary aid because their pensions do not exceed the SRA budget plan."

"The Red Cross is acting only as a clearing house agency for these veterans — offering this special service thru one of its many departments to bring about relief to veterans in this particular classification. No other class of veteran is qualified for clearance by the Red Cross."

Announcement during the past week that all veterans were eligible for food stamps was incorrect. Certification will be made only on Tuesdays and Fridays, during the hours of 9:30 a. m. and 3 p. m., beginning Dec. 3, at 1218 Menlo avenue, Los Angeles.
