

OBITUARY

ANDREW J. HARDER... father of Fred Harder of 1604 Greenwood avenue, succumbed last Sunday at the home of a daughter, Mrs. J. K. Keyes, in Huntington Park. He was nearly 84 years of age. Mr. Harder, who was born Jan. 20, 1857 in Savannah, Tenn., had lived in Huntington Park for the past four years. He came to Torrance in 1923 from the mid-west after retiring as a farmer.

Mr. Harder was survived by his wife, Mrs. Pearl Harder; five sons, Fred of this city, Ellis and Ralph of Atlanta, Ga., William of Burbank and Albert of Stanoway, Wash.; three daughters, Mrs. Keyes of Huntington Park, Mrs. T. E. Mann of Stanoway and Mrs. E. V. Strader of Huntington Park; nine grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. The funeral was held yesterday afternoon at Wheat-Halverson mortuary in Huntington Park and interment was at Inglewood Park cemetery.

WILLIAM WHITNEY... well-known baker and owner of Whitney's Bakery on Sartori avenue for the past six years, passed away last Thursday evening after an illness of only five days. He was born Jan. 15, 1876, in Independence, Kansas, and moved with his family to Craig, Mo., when he was a year old. From there he went to Council Bluffs, Iowa, where he lived until 1916. In that year, Mr. Whitney went to Palisades, Colo., and was married there to Eva Shaw. The family moved to South Gate, Calif., and later came to Torrance. Mr. Whitney was survived by his wife, Mrs. Eva Whitney; three daughters, Wilma Parker and Beverly Jean and Eva Whitney; and a sister, Mrs. Edna MacTaggart of Chula Vista.

The funeral service was held Sunday afternoon at Stone and Myers' chapel with the South Gate Masonic lodge in charge. Interment was at Pacific Crest cemetery. Mr. Whitney had scores of friends here and his sudden passing came as a shock to them. He was a member of the Eagles lodge in Council Bluffs and lived at 1804 Arlington avenue.
