

# Gambling Counts Against 6 Are Dismissed Here

After nearly three hours were spent selecting a jury of 11 women and one man and another hour or two given to introduction of testimony by Police Chief John Stroh, two of his officers and Harry Lynch, manager of the Torrance hotel where six men were arrested on the night of Jan. 24 on gambling charges, those accusations were dismissed by City Judge Robert Lessing Tuesday afternoon for lack of evidence.

"There probably was a card game in progress in the hotel room where the defendants were arrested but no evidence has been introduced here to show that someone was 'taking a cut' or a percentage out of the pot as is required under our law of gambling," the court ruled. "No corpus delicti has been shown and, according to state law, it is not unlawful to play poker unless the house or someone else takes a percentage out of the game."

"Off the record, I would say that the law appears silly because it is almost impossible for police authorities or anyone to prove such a cut or percentage was being taken out of a game unless an informer, or 'pigeon' is actually contacted by the authorities," the judge said. "The law is not admissible in court or the jury to speculate or guess in such a case and, while I realize I do not condone gambling, to convict these defendants on the evidence introduced."

The attorneys agree to a stipulation to dismiss the charges against the six men on basis of insufficient evidence was made by Attorney Milo Smith of San Pedro, counsel for the defendants, and drew no objection from Attorney George Bumpus who was representing City Attorney John E. McCall as the city's prosecuting attorney.

## Torrance to Get \$329 Liquor Fees

In the semi-annual distribution of liquor license fees, the city of Torrance will receive \$329.06, according to announcement of this week by the State Board of Equalization. The city's share will come from a \$432,061.80 allocation to Los Angeles county—the largest single account allocated.

The current distribution for the entire state amounted to \$1,283,331.32, representing one-half of the net fees of \$2,567,862.64 earned during the last half of 1940. The state's share, representing the other half, goes into the general fund.

Board records show that the current distribution, cities and counties of the state have received, since repeal, a total of \$17,785,264.16.
