Mary Lee Taylor's
RADIO RECIPE

Cream Vegetable Soup

Prepared by Mary Lee Taylor May 1, 1941

1/4 teaspoon butter 1/2 cup Fat Milk
1/4 teaspoon flour 1/2 cup diluted milk
Few grains salt 1/2 cup water off vegetable
2 tablespoons vegetable puree (see below)

Melt butter. Blend in flour and salt. Stir in diluted milk. Cook over boiling water 10 minutes, stirring frequently. Add vegetable puree. Heat thoroughly and serve at once. Makes 1 large serving.

For Vegetable Puree, put asparagus, broccoli, cauliflower broken into pieces, sliced carrots, celery, dried beans, cut green beans, peas, sliced, pared potatoes (not new) or spinach in saucepan. Add a few grains of salt and enough boiling water to just cover the vegetable. Boil until vegetable is soft and water has nearly cooled away. Then press through a wire strainer. You may also use canned vegetables, if heated to the boiling point, and strained, or the puree of vegetables that are now obtainable in cans.
