**Mary Lee Taylor's RADIO RECIPE**



**Fruit Shortcake**  
Broadcast by Mary Lee Taylor June 15, 1941

2 cups each or all-purpose flour  
2 1/2 teaspoons baking powder  
1/4 teaspoon salt  
1/4 cup soft butter or other shortening  
1/2 cup sugar  
1 1/2 cups well-drained sliced peaches  
1/4 cup sugar  
1 teaspoon vanilla (No. 2 can)

Turn on oven and set at moderately slow (350° F.). Grease a deep 9-inch cake pan. Sift flour before measuring. Beat with baking powder and salt. Cream together thoroughly the butter, 1/4 cup sugar and vanilla. Beat in vigorously unbeaten egg yolks, one at a time. Add flour mixture alternately with diluted milk. Beat until smooth after each addition. Spread batter in greased pan. Beat egg whites until stiff but not dry. Continue beating while adding gradually 1/4 cup sugar. Spread over butter in pan, heaping around the edge. Bake about 45 minutes, or until a wire cake tester or toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool. Just before serving, arrange peaches in circle on top of mixture. Serves 6.
