(Continued from Page 1-A) stoves, electrical dish washers, room-unit air conditioners, sewing machines, radios, phonographs and musical instruments made principally of metals.

One-third down is required on the following items: Automobiles, passenger cars designed for the purpose of transporting less than 10 passengers, including taxicabs, trucks are excepted; aircraft, including gliders, power

driven boats and marine motors, outboard motors, motorcycles and motor bicycles. Aircraft purchases are excepted if bought in order to facilitate participation in the civilian pilot training program of the Civil Aeronautics authority.

Materials and services for the repair, alteration or improvement of real property, excluding the items already listed, have no specified down payment but come within the ruling when the total is less than \$1,000 and must be paid off in 18 months.
