

START EASTER SEAL CAMPAIGN TO AID CRIPPLED CHILDREN

With a splendid record of accomplishment, the Crippled Children's Society of Los Angeles County has inaugurated its annual Easter Seal drive to raise funds to assure adequate care and attention for youngsters who are in need.

The local campaign is part of a nationwide drive sponsored by various State and County Societies for crippled children.

AIDS IN FINDING

"Our organization does not dispense direct relief, but functions primarily to find crippled children who are neglected, investigate their problems, and then place them in private charitable institutions, or, by invoking the State laws, place them in the proper public charitable institutions so that they may become rehabilitated and useful citizens," said Lawrence L. Frank, president of the Crippled Children's Society of Los Angeles County, and also president of the Van de Kamp's Holland Dutch Bakers, Inc.

Mr. Frank is being assisted in this work by Dr. H. Waldo Spiers, vice-president; Paul Dietrich, treasurer; Edward B. Dogroot, secretary and chairman of the seal campaign; and Mesdames Rute Downing, E. J. Harper, Mahel Fonda Wells, and Messrs. Edwin C. Rauth, Howard Roane, and W. R. Smith.

CHILDREN PLACED

"After the children are placed in the institutions that will do them the greatest good and their disability has been corrected as far as possible, they are educated along vocational lines so that they may become self-supporting," went on Mr. Frank. "Our Society helps in obtaining placement."

"There are more than 20,000 physically-handicapped children in Los Angeles County, a large percentage of whom are not receiving attention."

"During the last few years we have been fortunate in receiving increasing support so that the scope of our work has gradually increased and our record of accomplishment in this field has grown proportionately."

"It is noteworthy that our Society does not duplicate facilities for the care of crippled children nor does it maintain hospitals, educational centers or convalescent homes. It is to be emphasized that our Society functions largely in the field of making known and causing the application of the Crippled Children's Act No. 590 of the State's political code... relating to the care, treatment, transportation, and physical rehabilitation of physically-handicapped persons under the age of 18 years, by the State Board of Health and by and under the direction of the County Board of Supervisors."

MAKE LAW WORK

"This is an excellent law but it is not self-operative, and it is no reflection upon either the State or County officials to point out that it has required the initiative and efforts of our Society to make the law work in Los Angeles County."

SEALS HELP

"Financial support for the Crippled Children's Society has been received by means of shared returns from a State-wide sale of Easter Seals, voluntary contributions from individuals and business firms, and through membership returns. Only 3 Days Left to File Returns on Federal Tax

With only three business days remaining in which to file Federal income tax returns, offices of the Bureau of Internal Revenue were preparing today to receive the largest last-minute rush of taxpayers in history. All previous records for the number of tax returns handled and the amount of money received have already been smashed.

An augmented staff of deputy collectors is on duty in each office to handle the rush. All offices will be open from 8 a. m. to 4:30 p. m. tomorrow and Saturday. Next Monday, March 16, the final day for filing returns without penalty, all offices will be open until 10 p. m.

All persons whose total income during 1941 was \$750 must file tax returns regardless of the nature of their income. Exemption for married couples is \$1,500. Taxes may be paid in full, semi-annual, or quarterly installments, but at least 25 percent of the tax must be paid on or before March 16.

Personal checks, bank money orders, cashiers checks, postoffice money orders, or drafts, will be accepted at any revenue office in payment of the taxes. No check will be accepted in excess of the tax payment as change can not be made. Cash will be accepted only in the main office of the Federal bldg. in Los Angeles.

Offices where returns may be filed are located in Los Angeles at 4918 South Figueroa, 206 South Western ave., 538 South Amalia, 1158 South Hill st. and in the New Federal bldg. Other offices are in the Chamber of Commerce, Inglewood; Times bldg., Long Beach; Chamber of Commerce, Wilmington, and in the Federal bldg. at San Pedro.


