ORDINANCE NO. 335 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE USE OF SATISFACTORY SUBSTITUTE MATERIALS DURING THE PERIOD OF NATIONAL EMERGENCY.

The City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The President of the United States has declared a state of National Emergency. Due to this emergency, some materials in the building, repairing or maintenance of buildings, structures or facilities for light, heat, power, water, sanitation and similar utilities, are being used by defense industries, and are subject to Government priorities, and are unavailable for general use.

SECTION 2. Whenever any ordinance of the City of Torrance requires the use of specified materials for any construction, maintenance or repair purposes during the period of the present National Emergency, the officers who issue permits for construction, installation or repairs are hereby authorized to waive the requirements of said ordinance when the following conditions exist:

(a) When the required materials are not available for use because of the National Emergency.

(b) When substitute materials are available and are satisfactory to the City Council.

SECTION 3. The authorization conferred upon said officers to waive the requirements for specified materials, shall be operative only during the period of said National Emergency.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance, and the same shall take effect and be in force from and after its final adoption; and the reason for the urgency of this ordinance is for the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Torrance, due primarily to the fact that specified materials required by certain existing ordinances of the City of Torrance are not available and provisions made for the use of substitute materials.
