### Pay Increases Granted Seven City Employees

Pay increases for a number of municipal workers were approved by the city council at an adjourned meeting Tuesday night and Mrs. Myrtle Schumacher, wife of Capt. Frank Schumacher, veteran member of the department, was employed as a desk officer at a probationer's salary of \$125 per month. She is the third woman to be employed on the police department but Miss Lucille Stroh, a desk sergeant, is the only other one still on the force.

James Bergeron, Walteria fireman, was increased from \$145 to \$175 per month while others to receive pay boosts were: Jack Hallanger, deputy city clerk, \$25 to \$225; Dorothy Christie, \$10 to \$145; June Whitt, \$15 to \$125; Ruth Finney, \$25 to \$115; Walter Bradford, \$25 to \$175, and Mrs. Lucille Lewellen, \$10 to \$115.

Councilman George V. Powell's motion to advance two engineers on the fire department to captains with simultaneous increase in pay failed to receive a second, other members of the council contending that the advancement should be recommended by the Civil Service Commission first.
