

# War Chest Objectives Are Explained

(Continued from Page 4-A)

...serving the strength and spirit of our merchant seamen, the War Shipping Administration in September, 1942, created United Seaman's Service. In cooperation with the War Shipping Administration, this agency operates rest centers for survivors of enemy action and for seamen in need of recuperation from wartime sea duty. It also maintains hotels and clubs, where seamen may have comfortable overnight accommodations and relaxation between voyages. This agency is approved for participation in the War Chest.

**The Citizens Committee of the Army and Navy, Inc.:** This organization was originally headed by the late Charles Paddock, captain, U.S. Marine Corps, killed in an Alaskan airplane crash. The chairman now is Joseph Scott, Los Angeles attorney. It furnishes recreational and athletic equipment to training encampments of all branches of the armed services within this territory.


**Naval Aid Auxiliary:** This is a women's volunteer group functioning under the supervision of officers of the U.S. Navy. Its many activities include maintenance of a surgical workroom where bandages and battle dressings are produced for Naval hospitals, distributing layettes among the wives of Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard enlisted men, making of slippers for convalescents, operation of five canteens in the harbor area and the collection and reconditioning of clothing for the use of families of needy Naval men.

**The Women's Ambulance and Defense Corps:** Maintains 18 units in the Los Angeles area, which are engaged in providing mobile canteen services for the armed forces, in equipping and staffing casualty stations for the Office of Civilian Defense, in operating a transportation service for medical personnel, and in providing services for the Corona Naval hospital and other war agencies.

**American War Community Services:** This is a national war emergency organization, composed of six national social and health agencies which were formed to meet new war created needs in localities where facilities either are non-existent or inadequate to meet increasing population pressures. It has been included in war chests throughout the country upon the recommendation of the President's War Relief Control Board.

**The War Services Council:** Maintains a community canteen and recreation center in Westwood Village, Brentwood - Riviera and Cheviot Hills.
