Airplane Production Now 100 Per Day In Pacific Coast Plants

The Aircraft War Production Council, Inc., of which the seven major aircraft concerns on the Pacific coast including Douglas, Consolidated, Vultee, Boeing, Lockheed, Northrop, North American, Ryan and Vega, are members, has released information of interest concerning airplane production which has been cleared with the armed forces.

A statement reveals that warplanes are coming off the west coast assembly lines at the rate of 100 a day, one every 15 minutes, continuously day and night.

The November output on warplanes in Pacific coast plants amounted to 2581, as against 2,496 in October. Six hundred of the planes built in November were four-engine bombers, or 60 per cent of the national production, the statement reveals.

Some advice given to workers says: "The war is far from won. Stick to your job!" They were reminded that manhours lost in the past 11 months were the equivalent to production of 2085 Flying Fortresses; that it costs an average of \$200 to hire and train each worker, that the turnover loss this year at the present rate will equal approximately \$48,000,000 based on an average cost per fighter plane of \$75,000, just 640 P-38's, Mustangs and Thunderbolts which "failed" to blitz the Nazi and the Jap.

CIVILIAN DEFENSE DRILL

John Stroh, chief of the Civilian Defense organization in Torrance, has announced a meeting for drill at the Civic Auditorium at 7:15 p.m., Tuesday, Jan. 4. There will be distribution of several service ribbons on this occasion, Stroh said.

Police Have Quiet Time Over Recent Christmas Holiday

Except for a good crop of "just plain drunks" the Christmas holiday season passed off quietly in Torrance, declared Chief of Police John Stroh.

"We have been told that there was a scarcity of hard liquor," but there appeared to be some scattered around—at least enough to exceed the number of cases made of record last year," the chief said.

However, Stroh continued, it is gratifying to note that there were no automobile accidents of more than minor consequence and on the whole the holiday season passed with no crimes of major importance in this community.


"All things considered I think we got along pretty well," the chief added.
