**WOMEN INVITED TO OPENING WAR CHEST HEADQUARTERS**

The women of Torrance have a cordial invitation from Mrs. Curtis Albro, chairman of the women's committee of the War Chest, to attend the formal opening of general campaign headquarters at 204 W. 7th St., Los Angeles, which will take place on Wednesday afternoon, Aug. 9.

The afternoon's events will begin at 2:30 p.m. in the auditorium of Bullock's Downtown, when Mme. Francoise Dony, noted Belgian author, educator and lecturer will be guest speaker on "Homeless Children of Europe." Miss Clemence Gifford, noted contralto, will appear on the program.

Colorful ceremonies have been arranged at War Chest headquarters to be attended by representatives of many of the 127 major organizations serving "our boys, our homes and our allies," whose single annual appeal for funds will take place this fall. Civic leaders and other War Chest heads will be present.

A plan for the conduct of the War Chest campaign in large business establishments and industrial plants was outlined at one of the recent large meetings to further the appeal. There were present at Los Angeles Biltmore nearly 400 leaders of employ groups, labor unions and executives of 8000 larger concerns in the Los Angeles area, many located in and near Torrance.

A resolution was unanimously adopted which had been jointly prepared by representatives of all groups. It urged an employer-employee joint committee to conduct an individual campaign in each concern; that the equivalent of eight hours pay be established as a standard for contributions; and that management set up facilities by which payroll deductions might be made over a four months' period to the amount of the contributions, if desired.
