Drastic Cut In Car Certificates

Reflecting the drastic screening of applications by OPA to assure that only the most essential occupational users draw on the nation's rapidly dwindling reserve of new cars, the total number of new car certificates issued in eight Southern California counties during the week ending Sept. 9 was but 19.

CITY OF TORRANCE STATE OF CALIFORNIA NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS SEALED PROPOSALS will be received at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, City of Torrance, California, until 6:00 o'clock P.M. on September 25th, 1944, at which time they will be publicly opened and read, for performing work as follows:

- (1) The existing pavement to be resurfaced with asphaltic concrete. (2) The center thirty-two foot (32') strip to be graded and paved with a six inch asphaltic concrete surfacing on a six inch decomposed granite base. (3) Concrete gutters to be installed over the full length of the project. (4) All existing trees in center parkway to be removed. (5) Existing curb returns to be removed and replaced. (6) Other incidental work, as shown on plans and typical cross sections.

No bid will be accepted unless it is made on a proposal form furnished by the City Engineer. Each bid must be accompanied by cash, certified or cashier's check, or bidder's bond, made payable to the City of Torrance for an amount equal to at least ten (10) per cent of the amount bid, such guaranty to be forfeited should the bidder to whom the contract is awarded fail to enter into the contract.
