Delano was a student at Stanford University before he entered the service. He spent a year at Reed College, Portland, Ore., studying pre-meteorology subjects.

The boys' sister, Caroline, pictured in her WAC uniform, was one of the first Torrance girls to enlist in any branch of service. Due to the rigors of the eastern climate, Miss Delano was forced to give up her training and is now employed at Fort MacArthur as a switchboard operator.

**City Court October Fines Total \$1433**

From Oct. 1, to and including Oct. 31, 1944, the City Court of the city of Torrance received \$1,433 net from fines and fees, according to City Judge Otto B. Willett. Of this sum \$673 are general fund monies, while \$745.50 came from vehicle violations and thus are Road Fund monies.

Eight civil cases were filed during this month, six of which were small claims cases, making a total of \$14.

General fund monies were collected from the following cases: Drunkenness, \$390.50; parking, \$16; boulevard stop, \$72; disturbing the peace, \$90, and miscellaneous criminal violations, \$105.

Vehicle Code funds were derived from the following cases: Drunk driving, \$682.50, and miscellaneous traffic violations, \$68.
