

Excise Tax on Furs, Jewelry Not Deductible


Christmas shoppers were cautioned today by Collector of Internal Revenue Harry C. Westover that the 20 per cent federal excise tax on furs, jewelry, cosmetics and luggage, including hand bags, will not be allowed as an income tax deduction.

"Our office has information which indicates that a number of retail establishments are inducing customers to purchase the so-called 'luxury' items by stating that the tax is an allowable 1944 income tax deduction," Westover said. "This is not so. This tax constitutes a deduction only when it is incurred in the operation of a business."
