A progress report favoring the public acquisition of the entire coastline of Los Angeles County and of appropriate adjoining uplands for park and recreation purposes was presented to county supervisors by the newly appointed citizens committee on parks, beaches and recreational facilities.

The report was presented by Charles W. Elliot, landscape architect and director of the Haynes Foundation, who is also chairman of the committee of 16 prominent citizens named by the supervisors to develop a coordinated recreational program for the county.

The report presented dealt with studies regarding the development of shoreline recreational areas.
