### Rat Control Important, Says Doctor

Rats are carriers of some of man's worst diseases, namely: bubonic plague, epidemic typhus fever, infectious jaundice, trichinosis, ratbite fever, and dysentery. Certain animal diseases as well as transmissible by these filthy pests.

Destruction of property by rats, although not directly a concern of health departments, has been estimated by wildlife experts to be \$189,000,000 per year in this country.

Who then, is responsible? By California law, the responsibility of controlling rats rests with the individual citizen, and here in Los Angeles County our health code states that it is unlawful for any person to maintain property in such a condition as to permit breeding or harboring of rats.

A section of rodent control is maintained by the Health Department to administer the law and the ordinance, to advise the citizen who needs help, and to supervise the technical procedures of gassing, poisoning, and rat-proofing. The expansion of this health service in the near future and plans already under way by the department for a county-wide educational campaign against the rat will be discussed in this column soon.

In the meantime keep your premises free from old lumber and debris and keep your garbage can covered tightly at all times. Be sure that there are no holes in roofs, walls, floors and around pipes. If you don't want to live with rats, build them out, starve them out, and kill them off.

Let friendship creep gently to a height; if it rushes to it, it may soon run itself out of breath.
