Torrance A. C. won its ninth game in thirteen starts Sunday at Torrance but only after nine innings of great baseball.

Placentia Merchants, an all Mexican team, came from behind twice to tie the score and it was not until the last half of the eighth inning that TAC was able to push over the winning runs. The final score was 5 to 3.

TAC drew first blood in the fourth inning when "Buck" Kuhn got the first hit, a single to center, off Martin. Wells and Jackson struck out but Tex Roberts came through with a single scoring Kuhn.

After being held to a single hit for 6 innings, Placentia tied it up with a pair of bingles in the seventh inning.

TAC bounced right back with a pair in the bottom half when McCormick singled, Kuhn singled and Wells came through with a triple. The excitement was just getting started; Placentia posted another pair in the top half of the eighth, and with both teams warming up new pitchers TAC took advantage of two straight errors and a single by McCormick to score the winning runs.

Lefty O'Reagan pitched a masterful game in holding the Placentia nine to 4 scattered hits. It was his seventh win against 3 losses.

Great defensive games were turned in by Harold McCormick shortstop and Harold Jackson, first base, for TAC.
