No bid will be considered unless it is tendered on the special proposal form furnished by the City Engineer. Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check or bidder's bond in an amount equal to at least ten percent of the amount of the bid, made payable to the City of Torrance. Said certified check or bidder's bond will be forfeited should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract to do the work herein specified and to furnish the necessary bonds within ten days after the date of the award of contract.
