YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT WILLIAM J. B. HUGHES, a citizen, resident and voter of the City of Torrance, California, intends to circulate a referendum petition and protest of voters of the City of Torrance, California, against the adoption by the City Council of the City of Torrance on July 24th, 1945, of a resolution accepting the offer or bid, in the nature of a contract, between the City of Torrance, as seller, and Charles F. Koors, as buyer, in the amount of \$65,000.00 for the purchase of all automotive equipment, automotive spare parts, shop tools and equipment, including all of the tangible property used or useful in the transportation business operated as the Torrance City Municipal Bus Line, and pursuant to terms and conditions as set out in said contract, and each and every part of said resolution, voted upon by the said City Council on July 24th, 1945, and said William J. B. Hughes hereby publishes notice of his intention so to do and accompanies said notice with the following statement of the reasons for the proposed petition.

The proposed contract for the sale of the Torrance Municipal Bus Lines appears to be designed to benefit a certain individual or group who wish to acquire the bus lines at a time when, by reason of the expenditure by the City of Torrance of over \$75,000.00, out of the general funds of the City of Torrance, and the purchase and operation of new busses, the transportation system and is now conserving the needs of the residents of Torrance better than such needs have been served at any time heretofore. The purchase price of the bus lines is far below the present value of the property to be sold under the offered contract and there is no assurance that the residents of Torrance would gain any better service or even continue to receive as good service as they are now getting.

There has been no logical reason advanced for selling the bus lines at this time. The City Accountant's figures show that for several months past the City has been deriving an income of several thousand dollars per month from the operation of said transportation system. On such basis alone, the value of the lines should be correctly appraised according to present day standards, and if the lines are to be sold at all and taken out of the hands of the citizenry, a price of at least three times the present profited price should be asked. There have been no other bids, no efforts to contact possible buyers have been made, and it seems to observers that this proposition was rushed through the Council on July 24th, 1945, by a three to two vote, without any opportunity for public discussion or the exercise of considered judgment. The voters of Torrance should exercise their right of ballot to preserve their municipal property and to retain for the City the transportation service that they have acquired with so much difficulty and at high cost.
