

### Income Tax Offices Open In Torrance

Residents of Torrance and vicinity will have an opportunity to file their 1945 federal income tax returns locally, according to an announcement made today by Lionel J. Bailey, Long Beach Internal revenue division chief.

Deputy collectors will be stationed at the City Hall in Torrance daily until Jan. 15 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Farmers who are required to file original estimates of 1945 earnings may do so on any of these days. However, they may eliminate filing estimated returns by filing their final 1945 returns on any of these days. Others who will be required to file revised estimates because their estimates last year exceeded their original estimates can likewise avoid doing so by filing their final returns by the 15th of January.

Those who receive bills from the revenue office for their last installment of 1945 taxes must pay by Jan. 15, Bailey said.

The office in the City Hall will reopen in March for additional service to taxpayers in this neighborhood with their final 1945 returns and their original 1946 estimates.

### Fog Shrouds Torrance Bus Accident Here

A thick, dismal fog which blanketed the Southland early Saturday morning brought injury and destruction to hundreds of motorists scurrying to work throughout the county.

One death was recorded in the county, when 40-year-old Bradley H. Smith, 2959 1/2 S. Rimpau blvd., walked into the path of a streetcar, at 60th st. and Crenshaw.

Four persons were treated for injuries in Torrance Memorial hospital Saturday morning after an empty Greyhound bus, completely shrouded in fog crashed into a Torrance Municipal bus with 25 passengers aboard at the intersection of Carson st. and Vermont ave.

While ambulances removed the injured for hospital treatment, a car driven by Edward Freeman, 50, of 1618 E. 32nd st., Los Angeles plowed into the wrecked buses. Freeman was not injured.

### G. A. Huggins Manager Of Douglas Plant

G. A. Huggins, formerly chief of tooling for all Douglas Aircraft plants and later plant manager of Douglas Long Beach factory, today took over the post of manager of the company's Santa Monica plant, it was announced today by President Donald W. Douglas.

Huggins succeeds H. E. Guerin, who retires today after 25 years' service with the Douglas Company. The new plant manager, considered one of America's best known aircraft production experts, personally directed production of almost 10,000 war planes for the government at the Long Beach plant, including 999 Douglas A-20 bombers, 4285 C-47 military transports, 1156 A-28 attack bombers and 3000 B-17 heavy bombers, a total of 174,000 pounds.

During Huggins' three years as Long Beach plant manager, the factory produced the largest land-based airplane in the world, the Douglas C-75 military transport intended for use against the Japanese. A second C-84 now is nearing completion at the Douglas Long Beach plant.

Huggins lives in Palos Verdes.
