
BOOK DRIVE

BIKE LICENSES MAY BE REQUIRED IN TORRANCE

Licensing of bicycles in Torrance will start on July 1, brought about by the epidemic of thefts, if an ordinance now being written is adopted by the City Council. The City Council is going a step further, providing licensing, with each bike carrying a metal tag, it is said.

"Carol Drake's suggestions and ideas will result from a complete home testing service," continued
