Possibilities For Creation Of New Employment And Wealth Revealed

Possibilities for the creation of new employment and new wealth for the nation in general and California in particular are contained in resolutions adopted by the California Legislature in connection with fishing privileges in the Pacific Ocean.

The resolutions, which were recommended by the Tuna Fishing Industry Project Committee of the State Reconstruction and Reemployment Commission, memorialize Congress to institute a survey of the fishing resources of the Pacific and request the President of the United States and the State Department to negotiate treaties by which necessary Pacific Island bases may be acquired. The Legislature also appropriated \$25,000 for tuna fisheries research facilities.

Colonel Alexander R. Heron, State Director of Reconstruction and Reemployment, states that an increase in tuna fishing means more employment in factories where cans are made, in the canneries, in the distribution and marketing field and on farms where increase of protein feed for livestock and poultry will add to production.

The economic importance of the resolutions is pointed out in

bert C. Miller, chairman of the Tuna Fishing Project Committee of the State Reconstruction and Reemployment Commission. Dr. Miller is director of the California Academy of Sciences.

Dr. Miller states that the "vast reaches of the Pacific contain the world's largest untapped food resources" and that "the food protein potential is many times greater than all the beef, pork, mutton and fowl that can be grown in the rest of the world."

Dr. Miller's statement follows:

"The first meeting of the Tuna Fishing Industry Project Committee, which is composed of commercial fisheries executives, authorities on marine biology, and chambers of commerce representatives, resulted in agreement on the following points:

1. That the vast reaches of the Pacific contain the world's largest untapped food resources.
2. That modern operations probably make feasible commercial fishing operations in the far Pacific by coast corporations.
3. That a survey is needed to get more facts on the spawning grounds, range, and abundance of tuna.
4. That it will be necessary to obtain bait-taking and harbor rights by treaty from the nations which own certain Pacific


