What All Drivers Should Know

DIRECTIONS: These questions are Official and the same you are asked when you apply for your Driver's License. Test your knowledge by marking yes or no in the space at the end of the line. Correct answers printed below.

1. When nearing a curve and your view ahead is not clear for at least 200 feet should you sound your horn?.....
2. On a curve where you can not see the roadway ahead for a distance of 100 feet is the speed limit 25 miles per hour?.....
3. May you cross to the left side of the highway and pass another car if you are coming to a railroad crossing or a bridge and your view is not clear?.....
4. May you allow a friend to drive your car without a license or permit, so long as you are with him?.....
5. May your driver's license be taken away from you if you hurt someone through reckless driving?.....
6. When you park parallel, must both right wheels be close to the curb?.....

Answers

1. Yes. You should also drive as near the right hand edge of the highway as is reasonably possible. (Sec. 597 V.C.)
2. No. It is 15 miles per hour. (Sec. 511-a-3 V.C.)
3. No. (Sec. 530 (b) 2 V.C.)
4. No. You should not knowingly permit or authorize anyone to drive your car unless such person is properly licensed. (Sec. 535 V.C.)
5. Yes. Following a first offense of this kind your license would be suspended for 30 days. Whereas a second such offense would result in a 90 day suspension. (Sec. 307 V.C.)
6. Yes. Both right wheels must be within 18" of the curb. However this regulation does not apply to commercial vehicles when loading or unloading merchandise or passengers. (Sec. 588 (a) V.C.)


