Spare Stamp No. 49 in family ration books was made good for five pounds of sugar beginning May 1, and will expire Aug. 31, the OPA announced today.

Based upon the April 23, 1946, report of the Combined Food Board on sugar supply, OPA expects the same consumer ration of five pounds of sugar for each four months can be maintained.

National Family Week Endorsed By President

Peace has responsibilities of equal importance with the victory of arms, President Harry S. Truman declared in giving his endorsement to the interfaith observance of National Family Week, May 5-12, through out the United States and Canada.

This was expressed in a letter to Dr. T. W. Swearingen, director of adult work, and family life of the International Council of Religious Education, and secretary of an interfaith committee planning the observance.

Asserting that the home must be maintained or our democracy will perish, President Truman expressed his belief that the finding of homes is one of the paramount problems facing the returned veterans.

"I have therefore appealed to the churches and synagogues which administered so faithfully to service men and women during hostilities to continue their efforts now that the fighting is over," he said.

Clarification Of 'Stop' Order Of CPA Given

Clarification of the "Stop" order of the Civilian Production Administration as of March 26, 1946, on all construction; and new amended provisions of Priority Regulation 33, the order governing the current priority system have been received by the local FHA office.

FHA may now receive and process applications for priority assistance to complete dwelling accommodations which were under construction on March 26 and affected by the "Stop" order, McGovern said.

Further, the definition of a "Veteran of World War II" has been expanded to include, in addition to veterans of World War II, persons now serving in the U. S. Army, Navy, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, or Merchant Marine; the spouse of a member of the Armed Forces who dies in service during World War II; or the spouse of a deceased veteran of World War II if the spouse is living with a child or children of the deceased; or a citizen of the U. S. who served in the Armed Forces of an allied nation during World War II.
