Ohio Company Abandons Test In Gardena

Failure of the Ohio Oil Company to strike paying oil sand at its well located near the intersection of Western ave. and Redondo Beach blvd. was announced by company officials.

Failure of the test well struck a blow to the dreams of large oil companies in the area who had hoped they were in possession of valuable oil-bearing lands.

A group of residents in Alondra Park area may look upon the failure of the venture as good news as they watch with alarm the erection of oil derricks in close proximity to their homes.

This is the second attempt by the Ohio interests to strike a vein in this area. The first well was located a few hundred feet southeast of the second and was abandoned in December of last year.

While declining to elaborate on the future plans of the company in this area, officials of the company hinted that more experiments may be carried out as there are strong indications of deep oil deposits in that vicinity if the mud and water seepage problems can be overcome.
