"Waste Chasers" selected by industrial management to prevent fuel waste could help reduce smoke from oil burning plants, according to L. A. Deutch, assistant director of air pollution control of Los Angeles county, who today urged industrial management to appoint one employee at each fuel burning plant to check fuel waste.

"Efficient combustion of fuel oil usually results in smokeless operation," stated Deutch who offered to send these "Waste Chasers" helpful literature, to analyze sources of fuel waste.

SCHOOL BANDS TO PARADE IN L.B. WESTERN REVIEW

Approximately 500,000 spectators will line the streets of downtown Long Beach the night of December 6 for the 6th Annual All Western Band Review which has been revived in the beach city for the first time since 1941, when the colorful series was interrupted by the outbreak of war.

Forty top-flight musical organizations, preceded by more than twice as many trim drum majorettes will tee off from the "starting chute" on Cedar avenue just off Ocean blvd. They will proceed east on Ocean to American, north on American to 7th, west on 7th to Pine and down Pine to 1st, and then to Lincoln Park, which has been selected as the disbanding area.

Collectors To Continue Fossil Exhibit Here

The petrified wood exhibit in Torrance Library, displayed through the courtesy of F. W. Schmidt, member of the Long Beach Mineralogical Society, will be extended through December due to popular demand, it was announced here yesterday.

Continuing last week's romancing of the Fossils, Schmidt has revealed other interesting places where tremendous trunks of Redwood trees, which date more than 50-million years in age, have been uncovered from their graves.

Redwoods today occur only in the coastal range of Northern California and the Sierra Range near Sequoia and Yosemite National Parks. But it was a different story, according to Mr. Schmidt, millions of years ago. One of the most significant places where fossil Redwood has been found in the far north is on St. Lawrence Island in the Bering Sea, midway between Alaska and Siberia.

"It is far too cold and windy for trees of any sort to grow there today," Schmidt declared, "but in long ages past there flourished upon this island of St. Lawrence a forest as beautiful as that of the Redwood Belt."

When the ice was present during the time when fern and palm trees grew in the Antarctic Highlands, where they were discovered as fossil remains by Shackleton and later by Admiral Byrd during their explorations of the South Pole.

Climatic conditions on this earth have changed many times; where we now have constant severe frost, there existed a tropical climate, creating luxuriant growth. In millions of years to come, science determines, we may again have an ice age in the U. S. and tropical climates in sections of the earth which now are covered by "thousands of feet of ice."

"Millions of years hence," Schmidt predicted, "people may admire the remains of fossil wood from trees which sawmills now are overlooking—that is, if humanity continues to exist."

Mrs. Dorothy Jamieson, Torrance librarian, is cooperating with the Mineralogical Society in encouraging and maintaining the ancient display. The library is open from 12 noon until 6 p. m. and from 7 to 9 p. m.

Vets In Hospitals Need Sympathetic Understanding

The fate of America's 104,000 veterans in VA hospitals depends to a large extent on the kind of treatment they get from civilians in this crucial period of their lives, according to a statement issued by Gen. Omar Bradley, Administrator of Veterans Affairs.

In his statement, addressed to local USO campaign headquarters, General Bradley said veterans are now in a period which will determine whether they will become a burden or a benefit to society. "The veteran must want to recover. He must not be afraid to leave the shelter of the hospital life where his needs are cared for. The cooperation of the whole community is essential to fill these psychological needs."

"This cooperation can best be extended by USO, General Bradley said.


