Before the Veterans Administration can authorize payment for any claim made by a veteran or his dependent, the identity and eligibility of the claimant must be established. This is required primarily to protect the veteran and his family from those not entitled to receive these benefits.

Claims of beneficiaries (widows, children and dependent parents) are given priority at all VA offices. Everything is done to expedite their claims. Immediately upon notification of a veteran's death, a specially trained contact representative is sent to the home to give as much assistance, in every way as possible, particularly in the matter of filing applications for authorized pensions and compensation.

In many cases, however, beneficiaries must wait for their share of compensation because the required evidence is not complete. These delays can be avoided by checking with the VA as to just what evidence is required and collecting that evidence now.

The rules are not complicated. There are but two requirements:

1. Evidence of the veteran's service: Photostat copy of discharge is recommended, although the original is acceptable. There are some federal benefits such as farm, home and business loans which require the original discharge certificate for verification. There may be certain entitlements requiring the original, therefore the use of a photostat is recommended. If a veteran has filed his discharge certificate with a county recorder, a certified copy of this record may be used.
2. Evidence of relationship to veteran.

(a) Widow. Proof of legal marriage. If no previous marriages on the part of the veteran or his widow, the only requirement is a certified copy of the public records of the marriage. Legal proof of termination (certified copies of public records) by divorce or death of any, or all, previous marriages.

(b) Children. Birth certificate of each child. (c) Dependent parents. Birth certificate of veteran to show relationship to parents, or certificate of adoption, or affidavits proving "In Loco Parentis" status. Proof of marriage of parents. Affidavits showing (itemized) all income and expenses.

Secondary evidence in case of lost documents. Substitute proof may be accepted in case of any lost or destroyed document. For instance, there are at least 16 different ways relationship of children may be proved even though birth certificates are lost. However, it would be well to consult your nearest VA office to learn just what substitute evidence may be used.

In summary, widows and minor children of veterans of any war, and peacetime service, are entitled to apply for monthly income from the government (compensation) if veterans died from service-connected disability or disease. In such cases there are no income limitations.

Widows and minor children of veterans of World War I and Spanish-American War may apply for pension even though veterans had no service connected disability or disease. There is an income limitation.

Widows and minor children of veterans of World War II may apply for pensions if veterans received, or were entitled to receive compensation at time of death, although death came as result of other causes.

Dependent parents may apply for compensation only if veteran's death came as result of service-connected disability or disease.

4.5 Percent More Persons On Needy Rolls Of County

Los Angeles county's aid to the needy aged rolls for October, 1946, included 7,736 persons, 4.5 percent more than the 7,153 people on the rolls for October, 1945. California Taxpayers' association said today, making public its study of the first month of old age assistance at the new federal levels.

Aid per person in the county for October, 1946, averaged \$52.34, up 9 percent from the \$48.03 average aid for October, 1945.

Total aid paid out to the needy aged in the county for October, 1946, was \$3,912,704, up 13.2 percent from the \$3,434,500 payments for October, 1945.

Over the state as a whole, 164,485 people were receiving aid as needy aged for October, 1946, up 3.9 percent from the 158,331 for October, 1945. Aid averaged \$51.94 per person, up 9.6 percent from the \$47.38 average for October, 1945. Total aid paid out amounted to \$8,542,543 for October, 1946, up 13.9 percent from the \$7,501,114 for October, 1945.

The growing toll of mid-air collisions demands that the public should learn the truth, then place the blame where it belongs.

This article will discuss only the elements adding up to collisions on the nation's airways to be followed next week by one dealing with private flying on or off the airways.

The greatest danger that aviation faced in the past, and will always do the same in the present and future, is the failure of the human element, such as the pilot.

Such dire happenings can definitely be traced to 100% pilot error. Accident investigations of similar incidences proved conclusively that one or more of the pilots violated some safety regulation by flying with their radio receivers on their necks or hung on a convenient hook in the cockpit instead of listening constantly for signals telling of other aircraft in the same vicinity; by not occasionally

Tularemia Discussed By Dr. Gilbert

Tularemia, discovered in the ground squirrels of Tulare county in 1911 and named after this California county, is an infectious disease transmitted to humans through the handling of wild rodents or by bites of infected insects such as ticks and deer flies.

The germs gain entrance to the body through a break in the skin and after three to seven days the victim is suddenly stricken with a headache, vomiting, chilliness and fever, prostration and pains over the entire body. Symptoms are often mistaken for those of influenza. The sore or break in the skin through which the germs entered develops into an ulcer, the nearby lymph glands becoming swollen and tender. Illness and fever last for about three weeks with the patient convalescing slowly, sometimes over a period of two to three months.

There is no specific treatment for tularemia, although more recently experiments with some of the newer drugs such as sulfanilamide, have proved of some value.

Control measures consist of care in handling wild rodents, wild rabbits and other rodents. After handling or cleaning these animals the hands should be disinfected. Meat should be thoroughly cooked as the organisms will remain alive and virulent in underdone flesh. Refrigeration for ordinary periods does not kill these germs.
