"IS MY HOME STATE PAYING A BONUS?"

Thousands of letters pour into the may room of the Los Angeles VA regional office asking this question. No other VA office has as many state bonus inquiries due largely to the fact an estimated 100,000 veterans have moved into southern California since their separation from service.

Although the VA has no connection with state bonus laws, it is possible the Los Angeles office could answer a number of unwritten letters by giving veterans in this area such information as it has been able to gather.

TO DATE THERE ARE SIX STATES AND ONE TERRITORY which have authorized a general state bonus to veterans of World War II. These are New Hampshire, Rhode Island, Illinois, Vermont, Massachusetts, Michigan and Alaska. In addition to these, New York has a bonus plan awaiting ratification and New Jersey pays \$500 to blinded veterans.

Veterans from "Bonus" states, to receive application blanks and more detailed information, should write to the Adjutant General or recognized veterans organizations, in the state where they formerly resided. Application blanks are not handled or processed by the Veterans Administration.

VERMONT, \$10 for each month of active service up to a maximum of 12 months, or \$120. Blinded veterans who live in the state at least one year prior to entering service.

NEW HAMPSHIRE, \$10 for each month of active service up to a maximum of \$100 for 10 months' service. Veteran must have served honorably for at least 90 days and must have been bona fide resident of the state at the time of entry into the armed service.

MASSACHUSETTS, Originally provided a \$100 bonus, and in 1946 enacted new legislation to pay an additional \$100 for veterans who served at least six months in continental U. S. and an additional \$200 for veterans with overseas service. Must have been resident of state for at least six months prior to entering service.

ILLINOIS, \$10 per month for active domestic service and \$15 per month for active foreign service. Minimum of \$50. Bona fide resident. Next-of-kin will receive amount due deceased veteran; \$900 to next-of-kin if death occurred while person was serving in the military forces between Sept. 16, 1940, and Sept. 3, 1945, and death was service-connected.

MICHIGAN, \$10 for each month of domestic war period service and \$15 for foreign war period service up to a maximum of \$500. Bona fide resident at time of entry into service. Next-of-kin may be paid sum to which deceased veteran would have been entitled.

RHODE ISLAND, \$200 flat for all veterans including wartime members of Merchant Marine. Resident of state for period of at least six months immediately prior to entry into service. In case of death of eligible veterans, next-of-kin may receive the payments of \$200.

ALASKA, \$10 per month. Must have served at least one year unless service had been terminated by service-connected disability. Resident for at least one year prior to entry into service. Veterans who did not return to Alaska must have lived in Territory for at least five years prior to entry into service.

NEW YORK, amounts vary in proposed legislation from \$50 to \$250. Act must be ratified by 1947 legislature and by referendum, November, 1947.

1,455 NEW JOBS IN L.A. COUNTY ADDED DURING DECEMBER

Investment of \$5,688,000 last month in expansion of existing industrial plants and creation of new ones in Los Angeles county will result in 1,455 new jobs, Chairman George J. O'Brien of the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce industrial development committee said yesterday. O'Brien said 18 new plants were started, or announced, in which the investment was \$2,991,000 and which will create 548 new jobs for factory workers. O'Brien reported \$4,697,000 was invested in expansion of 41 existing plants. Nine hundred and seven new workers will be employed in them.
