


Help Prevent **FIRE** LOSSES

PROPOSED NEW CENTRAL FIRE STATION . . . Banked with shrubs, trees and flowers and with adequate park areas surrounding the structure, the proposed new Torrance central fire station to be located at Cravens ave. and El Prado will appear as depicted above in an elevation drawn by the architects retained by the city for designing the structure. The station, of one story, will be of sufficient size to house six pieces of equipment and

living quarters for the fire department personnel. It will fit perfectly into the civic center and will add to surrounding property value, officials said. The department will have equally attractive elevations, with necessary greenery, on El Prado, the alley to the northwest and the alley to the southwest. The cost is estimated at \$105,000.
