Robt. Dominguez, Member Of Early Family, Is Dead

Requiem high mass was sung Wednesday for Robert Dominguez, descendant of a historic California family after which the area of Dominguez, east of Torrance, was named.

Dominguez died Sunday at his home a week before his 84th birthday. He was born on the site of the present city of Compton.

While employed by Los Angeles as city clerk, Dominguez was influential in obtaining reform of election laws which won him statewide recognition.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Ettie Dominguez; a brother, Arthur, and two sisters, Mrs. Victoria Nunnally and Mrs. Anita Seaman, all of Los Angeles.

Ambulance To Be Used By Paint Dept.

The ambulance donated to the City of Torrance by the Kiwanis club for use during the war emergency in civilian defense corps, has at last found its "niche" in the community.

After the Mayfair Creamery had bid for the vehicle for conversion into a milk truck, the Kiwanis club asked for the return of the ambulance that the club might sell it and purchase incubators for the Torrance Memorial hospital.

The City Council rejected the Mayfair Creamery's bid and the City Attorney's office ruled that the vehicle could not be returned to the Kiwanis club as the city has "further use" for the ambulance.

However, in converting the ambulance for "further use," it now is to become a paint department truck, to haul materials and supplies for keeping up traffic signs and maintenance work of the municipality. The Council has allowed from \$175 to \$200 for the job of conversion.

Beeesmyer Tells About 'Phantom Freight'

Beginning April 1 six western railroads will carry steel from the plant at Geneva, Utah, to West Coast points at \$9.60 a ton—a reduction of \$4.40 from the previous rate.

This reduction came about when the Interstate Commerce Commission at Washington, D. C. ruled its suspension of the rate reductions proposed by the railroads would expire at midnight, March 31.

The commission's decision constitutes the exact objective we have had in mind and for which we have fought for more than two years. The commission's order also stated an investigation of rail rates on steel in the West will continue. Apparently, the reduced rate from Geneva will become the basis to which other western steel rates will be related.

The Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce and chambers of commerce throughout the west supported the rate reduction requests.

We were criticized in some quarters for our position on the basis that we favored a mill in Utah as against the Kaiser steel mill at Fontana.

We wish to state definitely the facts do not warrant this criticism.

Steel is the basic material of industry.

Los Angeles county has become an industrial area.

Two hundred forty thousand persons work in our factories.

The price of steel and its availability are strong determining factors in our industrial welfare and the permanence of the 240,000 industrial jobs.

Los Angeles industry pays the highest price for steel among American industrial areas.

This limits the markets for our products, and in addition makes it difficult in many cases for local manufacturers to meet eastern competition right here in Los Angeles.

It is necessary that our steel cost be lowered.

There are two ways to reduce the price of steel.

One way is to reduce the base price of steel.

The other way is to reduce the freight cost on steel.

The buyer always pays the freight cost on steel.

Los Angeles industry expects to pay full freight costs on steel shipped to us from the east.

Los Angeles industry, however, objects to paying "phantom freight" charges on the steel it buys.

What do we mean by "phantom freight"?

Example: A manufacturer in Vernon buys steel from a mill in Los Angeles. The steel is trucked to his plant. When he gets the bill he finds that he is charged an amount equivalent to the freight bill for shipping the steel from Baltimore, Maryland, or Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, to Los Angeles. This is one of many examples of "phantom freight."

Tourist Trade For 1946 Hits Record High

With 2,944,000 pleasure visitors who spent \$509,000,000 here, 1946 was the biggest tourist year Southern California had and may ever have again. The unusual volume, 70 per cent above the old record of 1941, was attributable to the postwar travel surge nationally which is now dropping off to more normal levels.

This was reported to a Board of Directors meeting of the All-Year club of Southern California.

Appeal Made In Suspension Of Fire Captain

An appeal has been placed before the City Council from the suspension of Fire Captain J. Benner, and a claim filed for wages for the period of suspension.

The appeal was made on the ground that the Civil Service Commission exceeded its jurisdiction in fixing punishment in Captain Benner's case.

Captain Benner was suspended by Fire Chief J. E. McMaster, tried and found guilty by the Civil Service Board, of neglect of duty and failing to obtain a radio operator's license. He was suspended by the commission for a period of 45 days without pay, including the period of suspension preceding the hearing.

The Council referred the matter to the city attorney's office, a hearing to be set for a later date.
