Credit Bureau Setup Explained By E. H. Lamb

"We realize that credit buying has increased 70 percent in the past 90 days," declared Ernie H. Lamb, manager of the Credit Bureau of San Pedro, at a luncheon in Torrance last Friday. Lamb and his son, Karl Lamb, were hosts to a small group of Torrance merchants, bankers and others interested in credit relations. Earl Lamb, who is in charge of the collection department of the San Pedro Credit Bureau, led a brief discussion of the processing and handling of collections.

The Credit Bureau of San Pedro has more than 90,000 credit reports available to its users, Manager Lamb stated. For the convenience of Harbor district merchants, much new and modern equipment has recently been added, which expedites the handling of inquiries, Lamb explained.

In addition to his files of credit information covering this area, Lamb stated that his organization is affiliated with the Associated Credit Bureaus of America, an international organization. In the near future, members of the local credit bureau and others engaged in the credit business will be invited to hear Ross Laird, public relations director of the Associated Credit Bureaus of America, who will speak on the operations of credit bureaus.

Allowable Tax Deductions On Cars Revealed

Sums paid as interest on car loans, for registration and license fees, for retail sales taxes on tangible property excepting the State gasoline tax, and certain maintenance expenses, are among the allowable deductions for motorists in computing Federal income tax returns, it is reported by authorities.

Losses and damages not compensated by insurance, resulting from fire, theft, storm or other casualties or accidents, are also deductible. Damages paid for personal injuries or destruction of property can be included, it is pointed out, but only when the car involved is being used for business at the time of the accident.

All operating and maintenance expenses, including the cost of gasoline, insurance, minor repairs and depreciation, are deductible items if the automobile is used for business purposes. However, in cases where the vehicle is operated jointly for business and pleasure, such expense and depreciation are only deductible in the proportion used for business.

California car owners are not allowed to deduct the state gasoline tax, or federal excise taxes paid on purchases of vehicles and accessories, when computing income tax returns, inasmuch as these taxes are levied upon the manufacturer and not upon the consumer.
