Dr. Don C. Moshos New Chairman Of First District Welfare Council

Dr. Don C. Moshos of Torrance was elected chairman unanimously of the First District Welfare Council at its annual meeting on Tuesday evening in the Woman's club here, when more than 100 representative citizens of Torrance, Lomita, Gardena and Palms Verde gathered to hear reports of services of Community Chest agencies here.

An enshrined Red Feather pin, emblem of national significance awarded for community service, was presented to A. L. Plasky of Gardena, retiring Council chairman, for his services during the last year. The District Welfare Council at 1229 Post ave. is headquarters for Community Chest health, welfare, youth and veterans services in this district. The Rev. Paul Moore Wheeler of Torrance presented the award.

Other election to Council posts were: Mrs. Edna Smith of Lomita, as first vice chairman, and Mrs. William Mowatt of Gardena second vice chairman. Frank Wilkinson, assistant to director of Housing Authority, City of Los Angeles, guest speaker in a vigorous speech denounced handicaps to better housing for the metropolitan area, which he said had been evidenced over a period of years. During the meeting Mary-L. Eggleston, director of district planning for the First District Welfare Council, was given a vote of thanks for her work.


Lynn D. Mowat, general manager of the Welfare Federation, complimenting the local Welfare Center on the increasing scope of its activities, reminded the local citizens that the report made represented only one-third of Red Feather services available to people here which had been largely used during the past year. These included clients sent to children's and orthopedic hospitals, various clinics and psychiatric services, children's homes, etc., of institutional character which take care of the needs of 17 cities and scores of towns to the metropolitan area.
