Contract For Alondra Park Lake Awarded

Contract for construction of Lake Alondra in Alondra park was awarded to Edward Green, who submitted a bid in the sum of \$22,196.00, by the Board of Supervisors at its Thursday meeting.

Announcement was made by Supervisor Raymond V. Darby, chairman of the Board, that the lowest bid of \$19,450, submitted by the Spicer Co. of Los Angeles, had been rejected because of the company's inability to complete the work in the time specified due to lack of materials.

Lake Alondra, said Darby, will be a fourteen-acre artificial lake located in the south central portion just west of the site in Alondra park of El Camino college.

Deal Completed For Purchase of Harbor Hospital

Final papers were completed Tuesday for the transfer of the Harbor General hospital here to the County of Los Angeles.

The county had been operating the hospital on an interim permit from the Army, and bought the property with a 95 percent public benefit discount, paying a total of \$96,543.62 for the complete property.

The county reported that the hospital is at present filled to its 600 bed capacity.
