Naval Reserve Recruiting Unit Visiting

A Naval Reserve Mobile Recruiting Unit, a semi-trailer truck specially fitted up as a traveling recruiting office and manned by an officer and four enlisted men, arrived in Torrance on Tuesday, June 24, and will remain until Saturday, the Naval Reserve Procurement Office at the headquarters of the Eleventh Naval District has announced. The unit, commanded by Lieut. F. S. Linhart, U.S.N.R., is making an extended "cruise" through Southern California to give interested men a convenient opportunity to volunteer for the new peace-time Naval Reserve. It will be parked in front of Safeway store.

The traveling unit can completely process veterans applying for membership as no physical examination is required of them. Veterans of the Navy Naval Reserve, Coast Guard and Const Guard Reserve will be enrolled in the New Naval Reserve organization in the rate they held when discharged from active service. Certain Army and Marine veterans who join will be given the naval equivalent of their military grade if their military occupation specialty number coincides with Navy ratings - now open.

Although the Naval Reserve is now open to non-veterans between ages of 17 and 40, the Mobile


