Laws Requiring Flame-Proofing To Go In Effect

Two new laws requiring flame-proofing in certain types of occupancies will become effective Sept. 19 according to a bulletin issued by Joe R. Yockers, State Fire Marshal.

The laws require all drapes, hangings, drops, curtains and similar decorative materials in any public entertainment building to be of an incombustible material or be treated and main-

tained in a flame retardant condition. According to the bulletin, the public should consult with their local fire chief before contracting for any work required by these two laws.
