Lions International Headed By Fred W. Smith, Ventura Leader

Fred W. Smith, Ventura, is the new president of the International Association of Lions Clubs. He was advanced by unanimous vote from the first vice presidency at the 30th annual convention of the association which closed in San Francisco July 31. Smith succeeds Clifford D. Pierce, of Memphis, Tenn.

The convention concluded the most successful year in the history of Lions International, according to the report made by the secretary general and founder, Melvin Jones, of Chicago, Illinois. He reported the formation of 853 new Lions clubs and the addition of 47,332 men to the roster of the association in the twelve-month period ending June 30, 1947, for a total of 3,117 clubs and 326,448 members. He stated that a Lions club was established in mid-July at Lisimore, New South Wales, Australia, and that there are Lions clubs in 19 countries. Lions International, he added, is now the largest, strongest and most active service club organization in the world.

The convention was attended by President Albert Isen, Secretary Frank S. Selover, Director Don C. Moshos, M.D., and Second Vice President Charles Gotts and Tall Twister John H. Ritchie, of the Torrance Lions club. Smith is a charter member (1923) of the Ventura Lions club. He is also a key member and has served his Lions club in many capacities, including the offices of director and president. He was elected a member of the board of directors of Lions International at the International convention in Havana, Cuba, in July, 1940, and since that time has held the offices of third vice president, second vice president and first vice president of the association.

Lion Smith was born in Alamosa, Colorado. He attended grammar and high schools in Colorado, a private school in St. Louis, Missouri and the University of California. His interests cover many fields, among which are education, land, securities,

banking and packing. He is a member of the California State Board of Education, having served as president of that board for three successive terms; trustee of Pomona college, Claremont, California; president of Hobson Brothers Packing Company; Salinas Land company; vice president of the Saticoy Rock company; president of the Ventura Securities company; vice president of the California Orchard company; director of the Ivy Lawn Cemetery Association; member of the advisory board of Ventura Bank of America, and is the owner of independent oil and ranching properties.
