

# LOCAL MAN DIGS UP \$100 CASH IN HIS GARDEN



A. H. Temple, 21725 Halldale ave., was digging for a potato, but instead he found a jar filled with more than \$100 in cash. The treasure, hidden in a muddy and rusted container, was unearthed in Temple's plot of healthy red Puerto Rican potato plants in back of his home last Saturday.

"I'll be happy to hand it over to the rightful owner," Temple said, "if he will identify the jar and the amount of money it contained, within two weeks."

The jar, about a foot underground, rested against a large potato which had been molded to its shape.

Temple bought the property two and a half years ago, although he has lived here 23 years. At present he is operating a sandblaster for Fritzen Sandblasting Co. at 21101 S. Figueroa st.

What will he do with the money if the owner doesn't claim it? Temple scratched his head an said: "I have a Jersey cow that gives me 25 quarts of milk a day and I'm going to buy her a ton of the finest hay. Then I'm going to finance another potato crop and if there's anything left after that, I am going to get a brand new checker board and a new set of checkers, checkers being my hobby."
