Sales Tax Is Renewed By City Council

Hugh Sherkey Jr. explained that the action of the Council in adopting the emergency sales tax measure was necessary because revenue from the sales tax had been only half of that anticipated.

Mayor Sherkey pointed out that \$31,049.02 had been collected through the sales tax compared to the budget anticipation of more than \$60,000. The collected amount had been used for a \$25,000 payment against the water debt and \$5,446.14 for rehabilitation of the fire station.

Prompt action was necessary in extending the sales tax for an unspecified period because of bookkeeping problems for both the city and retail merchants collecting the tax so that the collection dates of both the city and state taxes would remain the same. The \$33,593,000 valuation of Torrance, this year, with the same tax rate as last year, 99 cents per \$100, is expected to aid the city's financial picture.

Industrial Health Unit Is Praised

The Los Angeles county health department's division of industrial hygiene is the best unit of its kind in the United States, Henry L. Clark, manager of the Southern California plant of the General Motors corporation, said at the first Industrial Health institute held last week in Santa Monica. Among the subjects discussed at the institute were plant health services, industrial nursing, industrial health and the community, and utilization of the handicapped in industry.

Jobs available at the present time are somewhat limited to persons within skilled occupations, stated Mrs. Winona Ellis, manager of the Torrance office of the California State Employment Service. There is a need for machinists, auto mechanics, auto body repairmen, carpenters, electricians, structural engineers, stenographers, bookkeepers, etc. However, due to the seasonal holiday slump there are, few openings for semi-skilled and unskilled workers.

Mrs. Ellis further stated that temporary employment during the holidays has increased somewhat, with openings at the present time for experienced turkey pickers. There are also openings for male veterans and non-veterans. Anyone wishing to obtain holiday employment is urged to contact the Torrance office of the California State Employment Service.




