**Brazilians Fix Bird Own Way; Mucho Gusto!**

From Brazil comes an old recipe which can provide something brand new and delicious, in the way of a Christmas feast.

Into a large bowl put 1 bottle of good white wine, half a glass of white vinegar, salt mashed with five or six cloves of garlic, two crushed onions, four bay leaves, celery leaves, sweet marjoram, sage, two or three crushed red peppers. Puncture the turkey inside and out with a knife and rub this mixture in well. Let the turkey rest in the remainder of the sauce overnight, turning him occasionally.

Next day, after the turkey is stuffed, the old directions go on to say, clean him with a dry napkin and cover him with sliced bacon, fastening with toothpicks. Cover the turkey then with a sheet of waxed paper and over that pour the sauce in which he spent the night. While he's roasting, lift the paper once in a while and baste with the boiling sauce. When the turkey is soft remove the paper and let him brown. Serve with sliced ham, prunes, apple sauce and chestnuts.

It may seem like a lot of work, but try it on one of the two coming holidays and give a little bow to the good neighbor of the south.


