



C of C Cautions Housewives on Magazine Deal

Housewives were warned this week by the Torrance Chamber of Commerce not to give money to any solicitor selling magazine subscriptions until the purchaser is convinced that the deal is bona fide.

The warning followed an investigation by the local chamber arising from a number of complaints and disclosed that a magazine subscription firm operating within the city of Torrance within the past week may not be a legitimate operation.

There was no phone listing at the address given and was said by the Better Business Bureau of Los Angeles to be an unpublished number.

The bureau reported to the local C. of C. that the receipt used by the magazine firm "is not the type of receipt used by bona fide subscription selling agencies."

"However," the report said, "this may be a new selling organization which has not been made known to this bureau so far. . ."

The man was said to have shown a number of purchaser a city license.

Expansion Move Made by Local Equipment Firm

Expansion of the Precision Equipment Company, Inc., 1835 W. 220th street, into larger quarters at 1641 Border avenue, was announced today by company officials.

Organized a year ago for the manufacture of products fabricated out of super alloys developed during the war, the plant is the only one of its type in south Los Angeles, according to Richard Gilman, president.

Increase in orders for jet engine and guided missile parts made from the alloys has caused the expansion to provide for new equipment, company officials stated.

Gilman said that the firm originally selected Torrance for its activities, not only because of the city's nearness to the large aircraft companies, but also because the equipment company recognized that Torrance was rapidly becoming a hot spot of heavy industry in southern Los Angeles County.

"Added to the natural advantages of location and climate, the fact that Torrance also can provide low taxes, adequate utilities, good public transportation, and a sound long range housing program makes it one of the most desirable locations for new industry," Gilman stated.
