### Three City Bus Routes Now on New Schedule

Beginning last Sunday some rather sweeping changes in the schedule of three routes took place on the Torrance Bus Lines, according to M. A. Chamberlain, manager.

The Long Beach-Hawthorne line discontinued all El Nido trips between Torrance and Hawthorne. All busses will be scheduled via Western avenue, Chamberlain said.

The Local Route No. 2 discontinued trips to 203rd street and Western. Service on this part of route will be substituted by the Long Beach-Hawthorne line.

The Local Route No. 3 was discontinued with service to Pueblo substituted by Harbor Hills-Walteria Line.

The re-routing of the Walteria line will bring better week-day service to Seaside Ranchos and Hollywood Riviera, the bus manager claims. No service to these areas will be provided after 8:05 p.m. nor on Sundays or holidays, he said.

Between Hollywood Riviera and Lomita boulevard and Normandie avenue the fare will be 5 cents. The fare also will be a nickel between Lomita boulevard and Normandie avenue and Arlington avenue and Border avenue. The same holds true for the run between Cota avenue and Torrance boulevard and Lomita boulevard and Normandie avenue.

Chamberlain said the exact routing of the Harbor Hills-Walteria Line will be:

From the intersection of Cabrillo and Gramery via Cabrillo, Torrance boulevard, O'Connell boulevard, 203rd street, Arlington, Border, Torrance boulevard, Cabrillo to Gramery, then Gramery, Carson, Arlington, Plaza Del Amo, Cabrillo (Eshelman), 233rd street, Arlington (Narbonne), Lomita boulevard, Eshelman, 253rd street, Normandie, Palms Verdes drive, Western boulevard, Pacific Coast highway, Hawthorne Avenue, Pacific Coast highway, (southbound only), Roberts road, Capt. John Sharyne, Doris way, Robert's road Pacific Coast highway, Normandie, Palms Verdes Parkway, Cole Miramar, Via Miramonte, Via Alameda to Calle De Arroyos, Return via Calle De Arroyos, Calle De Andaluces, Via Pasqual, Monte De Oro, Calle Gramery and reverse of street to Arlington and Carson, then Carson, Cabrillo to Gramery.
