Census Bureau Opens Office in Navy Annex

Establishing headquarters in the U.S. Naval Supply Depot, Torrance Annex, the U.S. Bureau of Census has started the monumental task of conducting a business census of a greater part of Southern California.

He said that the 45 persons who will be employed on the project will canvass business firms within most of Los Angeles County and all of Orange County.

There is no way to get business information except from business itself. In asking business for information, the Census Bureau is not asking idle questions.

The 1948 Census of Business applies only to retailers, wholesalers and selected service establishments. Manufacturers as such will not be covered.

There is no need to fear that competitors will find out about the operations of any firm; nor is there any possibility of the data submitted being used for tax or regulatory purposes.

By the time the new figures are gathered, a period of nine years will have elapsed since the last Census of Business.


