

Gordon P. Larson, 39, was elected by the Board of Supervisors as the new Director of the County Air Pollution District in Los Angeles and Colorado. He joined Raymond V. Darby. He will succeed Dr. Louis C. McCabe on July 1st, when the latter leaves County service to accept a position with the United States Bureau of Mines.

Larson's appointment will be officially ratified by the Board at its meeting next Tuesday, May 31st. His salary will be \$10,104 per year.

Larson is a graduate of West Point in mechanical and civil engineering. He obtained his degree in 1933. During World War II he served with the Army Corps of Engineers in Maryland, Texas and Colorado. He joined the Air Pollution Control District as Assistant Director in 1948.
