'Love' Subject Of Scientist's Sunday Text

'Love' will be the Sunday Lesson subject in all branches of the Mother Church, The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston. The Golden Text is from II Corinthians: "Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you."

In his letter to the Galatians Paul says, "Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ..."

In "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" Mary Baker Eddy writes, "When we realize that there is one Mind, the divine law of loving our neighbor as ourselves is unfolded; whereas a belief in many ruling spirits hinders man's normal drift towards the one Mind, one God, and leads human thought into opposite channels where selfishness reigns."

Rev. Miller Starts New Theme Series

Rev. Clarence E. Miller, minister of the First Methodist Church of Torrance, will begin a series of sermons Sunday morning at the 11 o'clock service entitled, "The Will of God and the Problem of Evil." Sunday's theme will be, "The Intentional Will of God."

Subsequent themes are entitled, "The Circumstantial Will of God," "The Ultimate Will of God," "Discerning the Will of God," and "In His Will is Our Peace." "The problem of evil in a world ruled by a good God is one which baffles a great many people," Rev. Miller declared, "I am sure a discussion on the subject will interest many families.
