### Supervisors Told Tax Rate May Rise

County tax rate would go up from 25 to 30 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation if proposition number 4 is repealed by the voters next November.

This was revealed Tuesday by County Manager Wayne R. Allen in a report to the Board of Supervisors.

However, it was pointed out in Allen's report that state taxes would be lowered by throwing a portion of the tax load for aged and blind aid on the county again, and by reinstating more rigid standards for padding 25 cents per \$100 of valuation on the tax rate.

Allen estimated total cost in Los Angeles County for the Aged and Blind Aid Program in 1950-51 would amount to \$110,328,889, with the federal government supplying \$98,856,852, and the county's share \$11,472,137.
