Torrance schools do not get any state aid this year, as it goes to Los Angeles City School districts.


The county's state support for 1947-48 includes \$39,677,411 for elementary school districts and \$20,543,645 for secondary districts.

Notify VA of Change in Address. Each month a great number of checks for federal benefits to California veterans or their dependents are returned to the Treasury Department disbursing office because the person to whom the check was made out has moved and failed to notify the Veterans Administration of the change of address.

Pursuant to the provisions of the statute hereinafter mentioned and the resolution in the matter of County Improvement No. 1203 of the County of Los Angeles directing this Notice, adopted by the Board of Supervisors of said County on the 30th day of December, 1947, the Board of Supervisors hereby certify and will receive at the office of the Clerk of said Board in the Hall of Records, Los Angeles, until 10 o'clock a.m. on Tuesday, the 27th day of January, 1948, sealed bids for the construction of sanitary sewers and appurtenances thereto, and trench and street resurfacing, in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Resolution of Intention in the matter of said County Improvement adopted by said Board of Supervisors on the 25th day of October, 1947 and those of the plans, profiles and specifications in connection therewith which are referred to in said Resolution of Intention, and are on file in the office of the aforementioned Clerk of said Board; to which Resolution of Intention, plans, profiles and specifications, and all proceedings had in the matter of said County Improvement, the attention of all bidders is hereby directed with respect to the boundaries of the assessment district, grades and all other matters which are hereby, with and the same are hereby, by reference, made a part of this notice. The proceeding for the aforesaid improvement are had and taken under and in accordance with an Act of Legislature of the State of California known and designated as Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code (Improvement Act of 1911), and the bonds to be issued to pay the costs and expenses thereof as provided in said Resolution of Intention shall also be issued in accordance with the provisions of said Act.

Provided that not less than one and one-half times the prevailing rate shall be paid for any working time more than eight hours during any one calendar day, and for time on Saturdays, Sundays and the several legal holidays, to wit: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Armistice Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas. Provided that notwithstanding the general provision contained herein, Flagmen, Guards, and Watchmen shall be paid one and one-half times the prevailing rate for overtime (overtime shall be time worked in excess of eight hours per day or forty hours per week), and the straight prevailing rate for time worked on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays where such time does not constitute overtime.

Each submitted proposal must be accompanied by a check certified by a responsible bank or by a bond, payable to the County of Los Angeles in a sum equivalent to at least ten (10) per cent of the total aggregate amount of the bid, as a guarantee that the bidder, if his proposal be accepted, will enter into and execute the awarded contract, and furnish the required bonds in connection therewith, in accordance with the terms of the aforementioned specifications. In the event that a bond is submitted it shall be signed by the bidder and a duly authorized corporate officer acceptable to the Board of Supervisors.

The rate of compensation for any classification not listed in the schedule, but which may be required to execute the proposed contract, shall be commensurate and in accord with the rates specified for similar and comparable classification or for those performing similar or comparable duties. The time within which the aforementioned work must be completed by the Contractor undertaking the same has been fixed at forty-five (45) calendar days from and after the date of the execution of the contract agreement.

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 1770 to 1777, inclusive, of the Labor Code of the State of California, the Board of Supervisors has ascertained the general prevailing rate of per diem wages, and the prevailing rate for Saturday, Sunday, Local Holiday and overtime work, for each craft or type of workmen needed to execute the proposed contract, and has adopted a wage schedule, and it will be required that not less than said rates be paid to all such workmen employed or engaged on the work.

The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to reject any or all bids; and to waive technical errors and discrepancies, if to do so seems to best serve the public interest. By virtue of County Ordinance No. 4348 (New Series) all collection of assessments within the (30) thirty day period from recordation must be made by the County Surveyor and not the contractor.
